Church of Killaloe as priests.

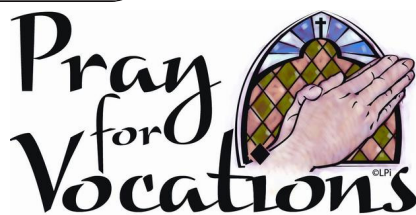
Inspire in them a generous response. Grant them
