Restrictions Update - The End is in Sight?

In light of the government's recent announcement on the next phase of dealing with COVID19 the following relates to the number of people allowed gather in a church:

1. From 6th September
50% capacity with social distancing still in place
2. From 22nd October
Removal of Restrictions

The consequence of social distancing still being in place means that the planned celebration of the 50th Anniversary of St. John the Baptist church and the 125th Anniversary of St. Mary of the Rosary church which was to take place on 2-10 October next has been rearranged for 19-26 March 2022. The organising team and the Pastoral Council have long believed that these events deserve to be open to an unlimited number of the parish community, hence the delay.

The current restrictions on numbers allowed into our churches continue until 22 October.

Extract from a Statement of Bishop Fintan Monahan welcoming the beginning of the Process in Preparation for the upcoming Synod

I wholeheartedly welcome the Preparatory Documents for the Synod on the theme of Communion Participation and Mission which we received from Rome yesterday. Pope Francis has asked that the whole People of God, in every parish, diocese or other Church grouping be invited to participate in a process of listening together to what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church so that we can make pastoral decisions that reflect what God wants for the Church at this time.

This time of listening and discerning at local level will take place in our own diocese of Killaloe and every diocese across the world from October 2021 to April 2022. It is my intention to enable as much participation as possible in this process. The aim is "not to produce more documents" but "to inspire people to dream about the Church we are called to be, to make people's hopes flourish, to stimulate trust, to bind up wounds, to weave new and deeper relationships, to learn from one another, to build bridges, to enlighten minds, warm hearts and restore strength to our hands for our common mission."
