Nenagh Parish COVID-19 Management

Prior to the reopening of places of worship for private, and later communal worship, in mid-2020, a Nenagh Parish Pandemic Management Group was convened and has met on a regular basis to devise policies based on public health guidance. The cooperation of parishioners has been outstanding. The work of Volunteer Stewards and Sanitizers has been overwhelming and will be formally honoured by our parish in due course. In light of the latest round of easing of restrictions, the group has met again. The following was agreed:

- in line with continued public health guidance, **face covering will continue** at Mass and other ceremonies
- the middle aisle in St Mary's will remain in its current usage for those who wish to remain physically distanced for a little while longer
 - hand sanitizers will remain in place
- the churches will be deep cleaned during weekdays

- Pouches will hang at the end of seats and will be collected at the offeratory.
Please do not remove the pouches or pass around but instead, place your offering into the nearest pouch as you enter your seat.
