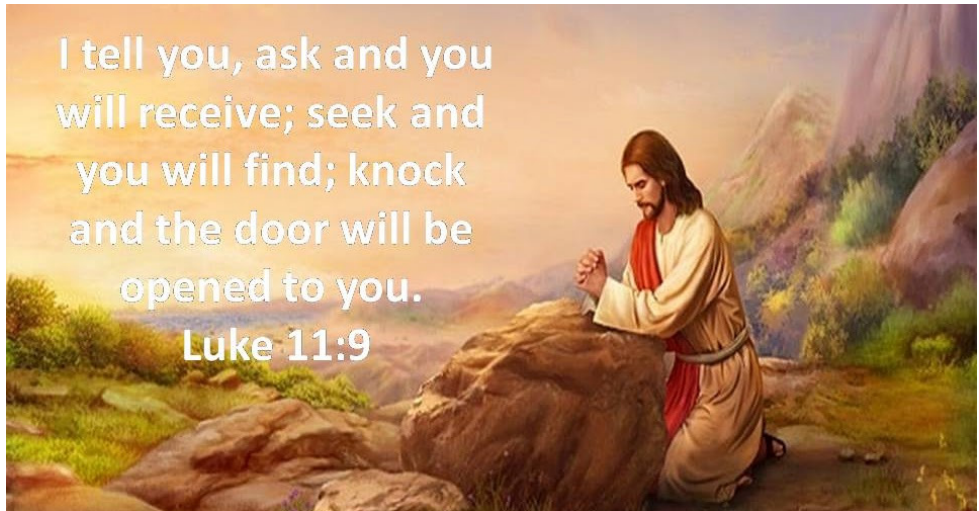

Beatification of Pope John Paul I
 The Holy See Press Office announced plans on Monday for the beatification of Pope John Paul I, who was born as Albino Luciani in the northern Italian town of Forno di Canale (now Canale d'Agordo) on 17 October 1912.
 Pope Francis will preside over the beatification Mass in St. Peter's Square on Sunday, 4 September 2022.
 Pope John Paul I's was the shortest papacy in modern history, reigning over the See of Peter for on 33 days. He was first Pope to choose a double name, saying he did so in honor of his two predecessors: John XXIII and Paul VI. He was also the last in the long line of Italian-born Popes which began with Clement VII in 1523. His successors—John Paul II, Benedict XVI, and Francis—have all praised the man known as "The Smiling Pope".
